Set a stone, 24" x 6" x 5", on east side of ravine for section corner to sections 2, 3, 34 and 35, T. 1 & 2 S., R. 30 E.

Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone loosely set (tipped to the west) in a mound of stones. The corner stone is 24" x 8" x 5" and is plainly marked with two notches on the east edge.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" flared, galvanized iron pipe 24" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone alongside the east side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe, from which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 32" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 35", attached at ground level, bears N46° 30' E, 86.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S2", attached at ground level, bears S38° E, 87.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S3", attached at ground level, bears S24° W, 72.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 34", attached at ground level, bears N32° W, 91.4 feet.

I nail a "witness post" sign to a wooden fence post at the corner.

I hereby certify this corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on January 30, 2002. Magnetic declination set in compass: 19° 30' E.
