History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by George S. Pershin, deputy, (compassman) on October 24, 1871, under joint GLO contract No. 154, as follows:

Set a stone, 18" x 8" x 6", on north point of spur for 1/4 section corner to sections 2 and 35, T. 1 & 2 S., R. 30 E.

Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone loosely set in a mound of stones. The corner stone is 17" x 8" x 5" and is faintly marked.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" flared, galvanized iron pipe 27" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone alongside the south side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe, from which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NE", attached at ground level, bears N43° 30' E, 143.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SE", attached at ground level, bears S43° 30' E, 116.4 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SW", attached at ground level, bears S42° W, 129.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NW", attached at ground level, bears N28° W, 161.2 feet.

I nail a "witness post" sign to a wooden fence post at the corner.

I hereby certify this corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on January 30, 2002. Magnetic declination set in compass: 18° E.
