## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by George S. Pershin on
September 6, 1878, under GLO contract No. 293, as follows:

PLS 1636

2000

Set stone, 17" x 10" x 8", on the south side of a ravine for the 1/4
section corner.

## Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone solidly set with one small stone alongside the south and one small stone alongside the north of the corner stone, and a large, rusty horseshoe alongside the west side of the corner stone. The corner stone is 17" x 11" x 7" and is plainly marked "1/4" on the east face.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 27" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the horseshoe around the pipe, 25" below the ground surface, and bury the corner stone along the south side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe, from which:

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NE", attached at ground level, bears N86° 30'E, 67.3 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 24" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SE", attached at ground level, bears S21° 30'E, 57.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 24" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SW", attached at ground level, bears S33° 30'W, 117.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 24" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NW", attached at ground level, bears N76° 30'W, 45.8 feet.

All four of the references are south of the bottom of Webb Slough, which is subject to flash flooding.

A 5 foot steel fence post with a "Witness Post" sign attached bears south, 1.0 foot.

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on June 23, 2000. Magnetic declination set in compass: 18°E.
