Set a stone, 14" x 8" x 6", for the 1/4 section corner.

Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone solidly set 10" in the ground. The corner stone is 16" x 12" x 6" and is plainly marked "1/4" on the north face.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 23" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone along the west side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe to the cap, from which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NE", attached at ground level, bears N29°E, 88.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SE", attached at ground level, bears S27°E, 79.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SW, attached at ground level, bears S55° 15'W, 99.1 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NW" attached at ground level, bears N25° 30'W, 125.6 feet.

A 5 foot steel fence post with a "Witness Post" sign attached bears West, 2.0 feet.

A farm road projecting NNE and SSW bears East, 30 feet.

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 5, 2000. Magnetic declination set in compass: 18°E.
