Original corner evidence recovered:

Found original corner stone loosely set in a mound of stones. The corner stone is 20" x 14" x 5" and is plainly marked "1/4" on one face.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 16" into the ground to bedrock. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the iron pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the original corner stone along the west side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe, from which:

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 21" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NE", attached at ground level, bears N64° 45'E, 89.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 18" into the ground in a small mound of stones, with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SE", attached at ground level, bears S25°E, 160.4 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 24" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SW", attached at ground level, bears S48° 45'W, 133.1 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 22" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NW", attached at ground level, bears N37°W, 124.5 feet.

I nailed a "Witness Post" sign to a wood fence post adjacent to the east edge of the corner monument.

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 13, 2000. Magnetic declination set in compass: 18°E.
