


Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found what appears to be the original basalt stone on the easterly edge of a turn out in the County Road. There were no visible marks. The corner point falls in the asphalt of Yellow Jacket Road. I held the intersection of fences running north and east as the best available evidence of the corner point.

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) At the true corner point I set a railroad spike flush with the surface of the asphalt stamped as shown in the diagram above.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps attached, stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N40°26'50"W, 26.15 feet under the west right of way fence; an iron rebar bears S61°18'2"W, 26.44 feet under the west right of way fence; an iron rebar bears N73°33'28"E, 76.98 feet under the east right of way fence; an iron rebar bears S69°59'48"E, 57.48 feet under the east right of way fence;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
