History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Daniel Chaplin on November 20, 1864, under GLO contract No. 107, as follows:

Set a stone, 16" x 12" x 12", for the 1/4 section corner.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a rough surfaced stone, with faint chisel marks visible, in a mound of stones. The corner stone is 16" x 12" x 11".

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Moving the corner stone aside, I set in it's place a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 28" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram. I bury the corner stone along the northeast side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the cap, from which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S10 NE", attached at ground level, bears N36 30'E, 146.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S15 SE", attached at ground level, bears S3 30'E, 124.9 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S15 SW", attached at ground level, bears S56 W, 111.4

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S10 NW", attached at ground level, bears N3 W, 142.4 feet.
