History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Daniel Chaplin on November 20, 1864, under GLO contract No. 107, as follows:

Set stone, 18" x 17" x 8", for 1/4 section corner.

Description of corner evidence found: The original corner stone is solidly set 6" in the ground in a mound of stones. The stone is $18" \times 16" \times 7"$ and is plainly marked "1/4" on the north face.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:
Moving the corner stone aside, I set in it's place a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 26" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone along the northwest side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe to the cap, from which:

A $5/8" \times 36"$ iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S22 NE", attached at ground level, bears N70 30'E, 95.2 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S27 SE", attached at ground level, bears S32 E, 113.2 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S27 SW", attached at ground level, bears S73 30'W, 149.8 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S22 NW", attached at ground level, bears N27-W, 110.5 feet.
