Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 22" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the original corner stone along the southwest side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe, from which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S28 NE", attached at ground level, bears N38 E. 141.9 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S28 SE", attached at ground level, bears \$39 E, 108.5 feet

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S29 SW", attached at ground level, bears S44°W, 104.2 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 35" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 S29 NW", attached at ground level, bears N42 W, 141.2 feet.
