History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Daniel Chaplin on November 19, 1864, under GLO contract No. 107, as follows:

T2S R31E 1/4 S34 S35 PLS 1636 1997

Set stone 18" x 12" x 8" for 1/4 section corner.

Description of corner evidence found: The original corner stone is solidly set, protruding 10" above the ground, and plainly marked "1/4" on the west face. The stone is 15" x 12" x 8".

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

In the exact position occupied by the corner stone, I set a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe 26" into the ground. I bury the corner stone along the east side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above, from which:

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S35 NE" bears N41 3/4 E, 110.4 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S35 SE" bears S28 1/2 E, 70.2 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S34 SW" bears S55 1/2 W, 94.8 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S34 NW" bears N31 1/2 W, 79.5 feet.
