History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by David P. Thompson on October 4, 1864, under GLO contract Number 106, as follows:

Set stone 18" x 12" x 5" for 1/4 section corner.

## Description of corner evidence found:

The original corner stone is lying on top of a mound of stones. The corner stone is  $18" \times 13" \times 7"$  and is plainly marked 1/4.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Moving the corner stone aside, I set in it's place a 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe, 24" into the ground. I bury the corner stone along the west side of the iron pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above, from which: A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 20" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S34 NE", bears N26°E, 84.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, set 22" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S3 SE", bears  $S80^{\circ}E$ , 57.4 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S3 SW", bears S54 $^{\bullet}$ W, 97.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod, set 34" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer attached at ground level marked "PLS 1636 S34 NW", bears N80 $^{\circ}$  W, 57.0 feet.
