

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 106 Dated August 16, 1864. Corner re-established by John C . Arnold under contract No. 551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 28 x 10 x 6 ins., 21 ins. in ground, at point of temp cor., for true Cor. to Secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, marked 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N., raised a mound of stone. 2 ft. high x 4 1/2 ft. base over Cor. on E. hillside.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)
An old fence corner at the intersection fences N., S., and W., on what appeared to be a small stone mound. The original stone was in the first rock jack to the west, up the hill.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 1" x 24" Iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the fence corner.

For references, I set three 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N03°29'34"E, 34.45 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears N84°33'39"W, 31.70 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S04°13'57"W, 30.28 feet under the existing fence;

A 1" x 24" iron rebar monumenting the corner to sections 6 and 7, T2S, R33E, W.M., bears S00°05'33"W a distance of 364.85 feet.

This monument and references were set and tied using a Trimble 4700 RTK GPS.
