

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 106 Dated August 16, 1864. His record reads: Set post for corner to sections 4, 5, 8, and 9, in mound of stone.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A stone 20 x 10 x 8 inches with an "X" on top was found buried vertically in a mound of stone at the remains of an old fence intersection with fences running North, South, and West. There is no wire left in the fence but there are numerous old fence posts laying along the fence lines.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped a shown in the diagram above at the position of the stone. Raised a mound of stone around the monument.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

- a rebar bears N0°04'E, 36.09 feet in a mound of stone;
- a rebar bears S88°54'E, 41.55 feet;
- a rebar bears S0°12'E, 25.39 feet in a mound of stone;
- a rebar bears N87°07'W, 34.08 feet in a mound of stone;

Monument and reference locations were surveyed with GPS recievers in stop and go mode.

The bearings are true. The distances are grid.
