

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 106 Dated August 16, 1864. His record reads: Set stone 20 x 8 x 6 for 1/4 section corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A stone  $20 \times 8 \times 6$  inches was found in a rock jack at a fence corner with fences running South and West. The point lies on the north side of a small saddle in the ridge. There are visible remains of a fence line running North from this point.



For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

a rebar bears S89°46'W, 86.89 feet under the west bound fence:

a rebar bears S89°49'W, 45.05 feet under the west bound fence;

a rebar bears N02°03'E, 60.73 feet in a mound of stone;

a rebar bears S02°53'W, 49.60 feet;

Monument and reference locations were surveyed with GPS recievers in stop and go mode.

The bearings are true. The distances are grid.
