
Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 106 Dated August 16, 1864. His record reads: Set post for Cor. to Secs. 12, 13, 7, & 18, in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, trench, etc. as per instructions.

Corner witnessed by John C. Arnold under contract No. 551 dated March 19, 1890. His record states that the post was at the corner of fences N., S., and W..

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

An old fence corner at the intersection fences N., S., and W.. The remains of a wooden post were in the ground approximately 1 foot east of the existing fence corner. The fence ran along berms in the hillside indicating the fence had been there for some time.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 11/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the fence corner.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N34°44'19"E, 69.35 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears N89°53'59"W, 35.61 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S01°00'28"W, 35.63 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S11°59'03"E, 128.94 feet in a small rock outcrop;

This monument and references were set and tied using a Trimble 4700 RTK GPS.
