

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

The corner was originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107 dated September 21, 1864. His record reads: Set stone 15 x 12 x 6 for 1/4 sec cor. John Arnold, under contract No. 551 dated March 19, 1890 reports "set temporary point" but did not report setting a final monument.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)
None. The position falls in a steep talus rock slide below a small bluff.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 2 1/4"brass cap on a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized steel pipe at the proportioned point. The cap was stamped as shown in the diagram above.

For references I set four 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N21°14'16"W, 37.95 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N09°30'49"E, 61.83 feet at the foot of a small bluff;

an iron rebar bears S76°24'53"E, 88.98 feet at the foot of a small bluff;

an iron rebar bears S06°40'26"E, 161.94 feet approximately 20 feet south of Stanley Creek;

These references were set and tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS
