

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107 dated September 21, 1864. His record reads: Set stone, 36 x 18 x 10 for cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33. The corner was reestablished by John Arnold in his completion survey under contract No. 551dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 14 x 10 x 5 ins., 10 ins. in ground, for Cor. to Secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33, marked 4 notches on E. edge and 1 notch on S. face; dug pits, 18x18x12 ins. in each Secs., 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, 2 ft. high x 4 ft. base along side, from which, A quaken aspen, 8 ins. diam. brs. N32°W., 250 lks. dist., marked T2S R32E S29 BT. No other tree in limits. No traces of any other cor. at this place.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)
None. This point falls on a 40° slope facing west with many animal trails.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the proportionate point. The top of the monument is 6" below the surface of the ground. For references, I set two, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps attached, stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears S19°00'28"W, 107.65 feet;

an iron rebar bears S26°43'53"E, 60.84 feet;

I also set two $5/8" \times 20"$ smooth copper coated iron pins with orange plastic caps wired to the pin as follows:

an iron pin bears N13°43'06"W, 238.18 feet in a rock outcrop;

an iron bears N58°00'36"E, 34.00 feet:

The monument was set and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
