
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by David P. Thompson under GLO contract number 106, dated August 16, 1864. Surveyor General record states:

Set stone 20x8x6 in for % sec corner



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone 17x8x5 inches with chiseled 4 visible, in a rock jack approximately 120 feet Southeast of the proportioned position for the corner.

See survey dated September, 1988.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 15 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing objects; A 5/8"x24" copper clad iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER bears N42°E, 11.45 feet. A 5/8"x24" copper clad iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER bears N49°W, 10.84 feet.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap. Placed original stone under the West side of the mound.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 1, 1988.
