

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract #551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 18 x 18 x 6 ins., 12 ins. in ground for 1/4 section cor. marked 1/4 on W. face, raised a mound of stone 2 ft. high by 4 ft. base over corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original stone, lying loose below the record mound. There was a divot in the mound where the stone had been.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of the original stone. Burried the stone along side. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 2.5" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, WALS 13922 and HADDOCK SURVEYING as described below: an iron rebar bears N29°47'47"W, 32.65 feet; an iron rebar bears N39°03'56"E, 24.36 feet; an iron rebar bears S50°33'01"W, 68.12 feet in the top of a small bluff; an iron rebar bears S42°11'27"E, 65.27 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
