

Corner originally set by James P. Currin and James E. Noland under special contract dated May 4, 1887. Their record reads: Set stone, 10 x 8 x 7 ins., 7 ins. in ground for 1/4 section corner marked 1/4 S. on W. face, raised a mound of stone along side from which, A fir, 20 ins. diam., brs. N25°E, 42 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S BT,

References to Range 34 East were obliterated and the letters UR added for the Reservation Boundary under the same contract.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A dead fir snag, 34" dbh, with a rotted face, grown over axe marks and blue paint visible inside. The record unmarked stone in a mound of stone at the proper bearing and distance. The stone was also painted blue on top.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above in the original mound. Burried the stone along side. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N40°32'05"W, 16.69 feet;

an iron rebar bears N67°47'04"E, 15.99 feet;

an iron rebar bears S05°23'43"E, 21.23 feet;

an iron rebar bears S45°23'24"W, 22.05 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
