

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract #551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: A basalt stone, in place 18 x 12 x 10 ins., above ground for 1/4 section cor. marked 1/4 on N. face, X at exact cor. point. Raised a mound of stone 1 1/2 ft. high by 3 1/2 ft. base about the stone, from which:

A pine, 36 ins. diam., brs. W. 65 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S BT.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original BT completely healed. I opened the blaze which was about 6 feet in the air and the scribing was plainly visible. The slope has eroded badly and there were no stones at the corner location.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of the original stone. Burried the stone along side. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 2.5" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, WALS 13922 and HADDOCK SURVEYING as described below: an iron rebar bears N36°27'54"E, 48.63 feet in a small rock point; an iron rebar bears N52°02'28"E, 31.56 feet; an iron rebar bears S66°03'44"W, 67.71 feet; an iron rebar bears S16°39'27"W, 65.21 feet;
