

Corner originally set by James P. Currin and James E. Noland under special contract dated May 4, 1887. Their record reads: Set stone, 12 x 10 x 6 ins., 8 ins. in ground for corner to sections 19, 24, 25, and 30, marked with 2 notches on S. and 4 on N. edges. Raised a mound of stone around it.

References to Range 34 East were obliterated and the letters UR added for the Reservation Boundary under the same contract.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) None.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the proportional point. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set three 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below and a brass cap as described above at the position of the closing corner to sections 19 and 30, range 34 east.

an iron rebar bears N26°00'38"W, 113.15 feet;

an iron rebar bears N34°42'46"E, 100.50 feet;

an iron rebar bears S05°23'43"E, 21.23 feet;

the closing corner bears N00°39'33"W, 246.33 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
