
A pine, 16 ins. diam., brs. S56°E, 2 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S., B.T.

A pine, 20 ins. diam., brs. N70°W, 32 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S., B.T.

References to Range 34 East were removed and the letters UR added to the east side of the monuments for the Umatilla Reservation Boundary under the same contract.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

Found a badly decayed pine snag with a location poster dated 1940. Found a stump hole with pine roots. The decayed snag had been dozed out during logging. The position falls within 6 feet of the proportional location based on verified corners to the north and south.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the correct distances from the remains of the bearing trees. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N44°13'11"W, 24.70 feet;

an iron rebar bears N56°23'01"E, 23.95 feet;

an iron rebar bears S45°59'53"W, 26.14 feet;

an iron rebar bears S40°58'49"E, 27.24 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
