

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract #551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 12 x 10 x 5 ins., 8 ins. in ground for 1/4 section cor. marked 1/4 on W. face, raised a mound of stone 1 1/2 ft. high by 3 1/2 ft. base over cor. on W. face of hill.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original stone, settled over on it's west face with a mound of one other stone. The remaining wooden posts from a removed fence indicate an E - W fence was near this location.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1" x 24" iron rebar 2" aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of the orignal stone. Burried the stone along side. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side. Built a stone mound on the west side of the corner.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 2.5" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, WALS 13922 and HADDOCK SURVEYING as described below: an iron rebar bears N26°29'58"W, 40.65 feet; an iron rebar bears N36°29'57"E, 22.88 feet; an iron rebar bears S19°50'01"W, 29.38 feet; an iron rebar bears S29°02'11"E, 30.41 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
