

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract #551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 12 x 8 x 6 ins., 8 ins. in ground for cor. to secs. 27, 28, 33, & & 34, marked with 1 notch on S. and 3 notches on E. faces. Raised mound of stone 1 1/2 ft. high by 4 1/2 ft. base over corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The original stone plainly chisled and firmly in place in a small mound of stone.



Set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of the original stone. Burried the stone along side. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N28°53'05"W, 26.67 feet;

an iron rebar bears N46°06'26"E, 26.30 feet;

an iron rebar bears S45°44'19"W, 32.70 feet;

an iron rebar bears S26°57'42"E, 27.99 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
