

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract No. 551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone 16 x 13 x 13 ins., marked 1/4 on N. face. As digging at this point is impracticable, I made a mound of stone, 4' high x 5, base over the cor. stone on summit of mountain.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

None. There is an E - W fence north of the corner point with many rock jacks. The jacks in the area were checked but I did not find the stone. Most stones in this area were flat and thin.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1" x 24" Iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the proportionate point. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 2.5" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, WALS 13922 and HADDOCK SURVEYING as described below: an iron rebar bears N32°47'30"E, 43.51 feet in the existing fence; an iron rebar bears N83°13'44"E, 64.79 feet; an iron rebar bears S43°39'16"E, 108.33 feet; an iron rebar bears S48°51'14"W, 28.37 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA SYSTEM 300 RTK GPS.
