
Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by John C. Arnold under contract #551 dated March 19, 1890. His record reads: Set basalt stone, 18 x 10x 3 ins., 12 ins. in ground for cor. to secs. 32 and 33, marked with 4 notches on E. face and 2 notches on W. face, CC on north., Raised mound of stone 2 ft. high x 4 ft. base over corner from which:

A fir, 10 ins. diam. brs. N65°W, about 100 lks. dist., marked T2S R33E S32BT.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A live, 32" dbh fir, with plainly visible scribing with a USFS location poster attached.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 1" x 24" iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the record bearing and distance from the bearing tree. Set a 6' steel post with a county monument sign attached along side. The pin falls in a visible mound but I could not locate the marked stone.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 2.5" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, WALS 13922, and HADDOCK SURVEYING as described below: an iron rebar bears N22°26'04"W, 30.45 feet; an iron rebar bears N25°06'33"E, 26.91 feet; an iron rebar bears S56°44'08"W, 17.48 feet; an iron rebar bears S54°17'06"E, 17.90 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
