

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by James Currin and James Noland under special instruction dated May 4th, 1887. Their record reads: Set stone, 6 x 8 x 14 ins., 8 ins. in ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on N. face, around which, I erected mound of stone, 18 ins. high with 3 1/2 foot base.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found the original basalt stone, in place, poorly marked, in a mound of stone near the correct distance east of the gulch. The stone was the record size.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At the position of the original stone I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap attached, 24 inches in the ground to bedrock. I buried the original stone along side and made a small mound of stone and dirt around the cap. The cap was stamped as shown in the diagram above.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N65°37'23"W, 23.50 feet;

an iron rebar bears N25°14'40"E, 29.49 feet;

an iron rebar bears N85°37'28"E, 71.36 feet;

an iron rebar bears S55°56'25"E, 74.19 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
