

The north - south fence and the burnt remains of a wooden stake lying on the ground.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above under the existing fence at the point determined from monuments set under survey Q-506-A.

For references I set four 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N43°00'45"W, 152.22 feet at the east end of a stop brace for an irrigation pivot.

an iron rebar bears N01°07'43"W, 45.32 feet near the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S00°14'37"E, 44.32 feet near a railroad tie in the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S00°25'34"W, 177.39 feet near a power pole west of the existing fence;

These references were set and tied used a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS
