

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above in the north bank of a ditch at the point determined from monuments set under survey Q-506-A.

For references I set four 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N00°27'55"E, 87.09 feet at the corner of a north - south fence and the end of a driveway fence.

an iron rebar bears S47°58'18"W, 54.36 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S20°18'37"W, 37.37 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S44°22'47"E, 19.33 feet near the existing fence corner;
