

I set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above about 4 feet south of an existing east - west fence.

For references I set four 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below: an iron rebar bears S87°41'13"W, 138.03 feet at the base of a power pole; an iron rebar bears N83°31'22"W, 49.47 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears N83°17'08"E, 34.42 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S83°46'18"E, 107.33 feet at the base of a power pole;
