LOCATION: From main street in the City of Echo go southwest on Oregon Highway 320 approximately 1 1/2 miles to the intersection with Echo Meadows Rd. Go north on Echo Meadows Rd. approximately 2 1/2 miles to the intersection with Correa Lane. Go east on Correa lane 1/2 mile. The cap is about 2 feet east of the west gate post on the south side of the lane where the lane turns to the south along the irrigation dike. There is a irrigation fish control device about 100 feet north of the corner. The cap is below the surface of the ground.

STATION: Station is a 2 1/4 inch brass disc on a galvanized iron pipe approximately 6 inches below the surface of the dike.



PLS 346 set an axle housing over a found stone with an "X" in survey Q-511-Ax. PLS 933 set a brass cap at the position of a found 3/4" pipe in 1974 under survey No. 98-11-B.

Found the brass cap found by PLS 933 six inches below the surface on the west side of the existing dike.
