

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner was originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 83 dated July 22, 1859. His record reads: Set post for corner to Secs. 5, 6, 32, and 33 in mound of earth and stone. In survey Q-515-Ax, Elmo Robnette tied this corner but did not identify the monument.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A porous red basalt stone set in an east-west fence in line with possessory lines to the south. The remains of a stone mound are scattered about at this point.



## MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At the position of the stone in the fence line I drilled a hole 6 inches in the bedrock and cemented a 5/8"x12" iron rebar over which I cemented a 1 1/2"x10" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 3/8" brass cap attached stamped as shown in the diagram above. The cap is about 2 inches above the surface with a small mound of stone around it.

For references I set four 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with orange plastic caps attached stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

An iron rebar bears S45°45'44"E 34.54 feet;

An iron rebar bears S61°31'05"W 22.36 feet;

An iron rebar bears N39°23'41"W 40.68 feet;

An iron rebar bears N11°51'29"E 54.52 feet;

The monument was tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
