PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS ETC.: Corner originally established by D. S. Payne, under Contract 100, dated August, 1, 1861. Notes state: Set charred stake with mound trench and pits as per instrs. for corner to to sections 12 & 13 R31 and 7 & 18, R32 Town 3 North. John Kimbrell, in his survey recorded in Record of Private Survey Book 1, Page 424, in 1900, reports setting a stone for the corner point. Frank Hayes, in undated Survey No. Q-521-C, states he set a 6 by 8 by 12" marked stone, 18" deep for the corner. Hayes measurements along the North line of the NW1/4 of Section 18 appear to be in error by about 100 feet.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None.

MONUMENT SET: Held the intersection of the proportional latitude between the West 1/4 corner of Section 6 and the Southwest corner of Section 18 with a North-South field line as best remaining evidence of the original corner point. At the reestablished corner point, set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with top 20" below ground, marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail", from which:

A silver deep-1 magnet, buried 20" below ground, bears North 50° East, 29.4 feet. A pink deep-1 magnet, buried 20" below ground, bears South 34° East, 33.9 feet. A blue deep-1 magnet, buried 20" below ground, bears South 46° West, 29.5 feet. An orange deep-1 magnet, buried 20" below ground, bears North 46 1/2° West, 36.0 feet. Buried bearing object tags with magnets.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner approximately 200' +/- North of Despain Gulch Road in North-South field line.
