MONUMENT SET:

Re-established corner by holding record proportioned departure between the reestablished Northeast and Northwest corners of Section 21. For latitude, I held a line extended West from the reestablished Northeast corner of Section 21, through a section of old fence line, and intersected this extended line with calculated departure at the corner point. At the reestablished corner position, set a 2 3/8" brass cap on 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with cap 4" above ground level and surrounded with mound of earth and stone. Monument marked as shown in monument marking detail.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372" bears North 76 1/2° East, 37.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372" bears South 12° East, 33.3 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372" bears South 82 1/2° West, 30.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372" bears North 37 1/2° West, 29.3 feet.
