MONUMENT SET: Held the intersection of proportional latitude between the West 1/4 corner of Section 6 and Southwest corner of Section 18 with a North-South field line as best remaining evidence of the original corner location. At the reestablished corner point set a reestablished corner with a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with top 20" below ground level, marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail", from which:

A silver deep-1 magnet, buried 20" in ground, bears North 46 1/2° East, 39.0 feet. A pink deep-1 magnet, buried 20" in ground, bears South 42° East, 42.6 feet. A blue deep-1 magnet, buried 20" in ground, bears South 47 1/2° West, 33.4 feet. An orange deep-1 magnet, buried 20" in ground, bears North 44 1/2° West, 29.2 feet. Buried bearing object tags with magnets.
