

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract No. 107 Dated September 21, 1864. His record reads: Set post for corner to Sec.s 22, 23, 26, & 27 in mound of earth with charred stake, pits and C as per instructions.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)
Railroad tie and plow lines running east, west, and south.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 2 1/2" Brass cap on a 1 1/4"x30" galvanized iron pipe 29" in the ground on the west side of the railroad tie at the intersection of the plow lines. The position agrees very well with the identified corners 3N32R13 and 3N32Z17 in distance from those corners.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 2' below the surface in plowed fields as described below:

- a rebar bears N87°20'W, 16.30 feet;
- a rebar bears N01°26'W, 16.55 feet;
- a rebar bears N89°25'E, 15.94 feet;
- a rebar bears S00°52'E, 17.67 feet;

The monument was surveyed and references tied using Two wild System 200 GPS recievers.
