

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by Daniel Chaplin under contract #107 dated September 21, 1864. His record reads: Set post for corner to secs. 29, 30, 31, & 32 in mound of earth with charred stalpits & c. as per instructions. The corner was re-established by John Kimbrell under survey in Book 1 page 542 of the record of private surveys, March 15, 1904. His record reads: Set stone 18 x 12 > 8" in a mound of stone.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The stone set by Kimbrell in a mound of stone well settled in the ground.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the position of Kimbrell's stone. Raised a mound of stone, 3' base x 1 1/2' high around the monument. Set a 6 foot steel fence post with a County monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N43°24'26"W, 29.09 feet:

an iron rebar bears N60°56'05"E, 21.64 feet;

an iron rebar bears S60°31'57"W, 32.34 feet;

an iron rebar bears S44°12'12"E, 32.32 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
