

John Kimbrell reports setting a temporary corner here in surveys filed in Book 1 of the record of private surveys at pages 526 and 542. He does not say he ever set a permanent corner mark.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) None.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
Set a 11/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the true corner point. Raised a mound of stone with a 2 1/2 foot base by 1 foot high around the monument. Set a 6 foot steel post with a County monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N2°06'36"W, 74.81 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N1°33'46"W, 40.02 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N86°40'32"W, 71.73 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N85°16'54"W, 43.82 feet under the existing fence;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA system 300 RTK GPS.
