A 5/8"X24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" purple plastic cap marked "Wells Surveying PLS 54657" flush with ground level at the Easterly edge of a gravel driveway bears South 00°17'05" West, 135.71 feet.

A 5/8"X24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" purple plastic cap marked "Wells Surveying PLS 54657" 1" below ground level bears North 89°59'31" West, 406.04 feet.

A 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" 12" above ground level in the Easterly face of a 10" maple tree North 80° West, 6.8 feet. Attached witness post sign to tree.

The most Southwesterly corner of a concrete house foundation at ground level bears North 75° East, 27.4 feet.
