MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None. Held the intersection of the centerline of Homly Road North-South with a field berm extending East and West as the best remaining evidence of the corner.

MONUMENT SET: Sub-base of road has very large rocks starting 12" below surface. Because of this a brass capped piped monument could not be set. At the corner point set a 2" aluminum cap on 5/8"x30" rebar with the top of the cap 10" below gravel road surface. Monument marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".

From which:

A silver Deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground in a farmed field bears GRID AZIMUTH 39°48', 50.6 feet.

A 5/8"x24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" blue plastic cap marked "Wells Surveying PLS 54657" 2" above ground bears GRID AZIMUTH 100°00', 15.6 feet.

A blue Deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground at the edge of the road bears GRID AZIMUTH 216°22', 41.5 feet.

A orange Deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground in a farmed field bears GRID AZIMUTH 315°36', 44.3 feet.

Buried bearing object tags with magnets. Wired bearing object tag to rebar. Attached witness post sign to railroad tie marker post 20' +/- East of the Monument.
