COUNTY: Umatilla DATE: 9/21/95

CORNER DESIGNATION: X-21. West 1/4 corner Section 36, T3N., R35E., W.M.

PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS, ETC.: Most recent approved GLO Survey was made by James P. Currin and James Nolin under Special Instructions dated May 4, 1887. Surveyor General Notes state:

Set a post 3 ft. long 3 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 Sec. cor. Marked 1/4 S. on W. face, from which

A pine 6 ins. diam. bears N.88°E. 36 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S.B.T.

A pine, 6 ins. diam. bears S.35°W. 31 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S. B.T.

Re-established by C.E. Redfield in 1918, notes state: No trace of 1/4 cor. set stake.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: A bent 2" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap (marked as shown in monument detail).

MONUMENT MARKING DETAIL:

INDIAN ALLOTMENT



MONUMENT SET: At position where the found bent over iron pipe with brass cap became straight into the ground, set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", 6" below ground.

New Accessories:

A 5" choke cherry with a double blaze scribed "X BT" bears S 53° E, 11.7 feet with a bearing object tag attached and with a 1/2" brass washer marked "PLS 1106" nailed to lower blaze.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears S 10° E, 12.8 feet.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears N 52° W, 13.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears N 2° W, 15.7 feet.

Attached bearing object sign to each iron pin, and attached survey monument sign to fence post near each iron pin.

LOCATION & COMMENTS:

Corner falls approximately 700 feet South of county road; 1 foot Northwest of fence corner with fences running North, East, and South; at the East edge of large pasture.

COMPASS DECLINATION: 18° East.
