Redfield retraced this line in 1919 and set a 1 steel pipe with brass cap in place of Currin and 1996 1 Noland's original monuments. In addition, Redfield setl PLS 852 1 a steel pipe with brass cap for the sixteenth corners.1 Redfield's record does not state what measurement the sixteenth corner was set at. Therefore it is assumed that the original monument was set at the midpoint between the Currin and Noland monument locations. Description of corner evidence found: No evidence of the original corner was found. The proportioned point fell on about 1 foot east of a north-south fence line. Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At the midpoint of the line between the found section corner to the south and the quarter corner to the north, I set a 2 1/2 inch by 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2 inch aluminum cap, stamped as shown in the diagram above 12 inches into the ground surrounded by a stone mound. From which: I set two 5/8 inch by 24 inch steel rods with aluminum cap stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 and B.O. These bearing objects bear N48 03'E, 21.7' and S45 21'E, 29.0'.
