
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Campbell under contract No. 918 in 1900, set Ironstone, 10"X6"X5", above ground, stone mound, Fir, 6" diam, N.10°E., 35 links Fir, 8" diam., N.20°W., 56 links Note: No restoration notes appear in county records.

Set a 2½" diam. brass cap in a 2"X30" iron pipe at corner and buried cornerstone alongside pipe. Raised rock mound.
