
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally monumented by William H. Odell under contract No. 114 in 1866, and again by William E. Campbell under contract No. 918 in 1900,

Stone, 24"X12"X4", 18" in the ground, marked % on West face. 10" diam., Fir, N. 10°W., 50 links, marked 14SBT. Note: No restoration notes appear in county records.



Description of corner evidence found:

Downed and rotted B.T. with reverse scribing, N.10°W., 23.0', (33.0') from cornerstone. Cornstone set firmly in place, no marks visible on stone.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

C.J. MARTIN SURVEYING 2751 JUNIPER ST. SWEET HOME, OR 97386

Set a 21/2" diam. brass cap in a 2"X30" iron pipe at corner and buried cornerstone alongside pipe.

1982 12" D.B.H. White Fir, S.29°W.,2.0', scribed %S36BT 6" D.B.H. White Fir, N.87°W., 12.5' scribed %S36BT Both B.T's. have brass washers marked RPLS 1910 between B&T, red painted bands, B.T. tags and attention signs. Steel fence post 4.0'± North and South of Corner with Attention, monument and boundary signs attached.
