

32" D.B.H. Douglas Fir snag, S.40°W., 13.9', with scribes visible 36" D.B.H. White Fir snag, N.43°W., (N.30°W.), 50.8' (65links) with reverse scribes visible

Set a 2½" diam. brass cap on a 2"x30" iron pipe at record bearing and distance from Southwest B.T. as this is best fit from evidence available. Bearing and distance from Northwest B.T. will not fit but face of tree points to corner.
