
## HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Set a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown above, 24" in ground, from which: A Fir, 14" diam., scribed "CE 1/16 S1 BT" bears N 46 1/4° E, 70.2 ft. A Fir, 13" diam., scribed "CE 1/16 S1 BT" bears N 82 1/2°

W, 40.0 ft.

Set a steel post 3' South of corner, with sign 54-4.



## DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe, flush with ground and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown, from which:

A 15" Fir stump bears North 46° East a dist. of 70.20 ft., standing 6' tall with healed blaze.

A 15" Fir stump bears North 82° West a dist. of 40.00 ft., standing 6' tall with healed blaze.

Steel fencepost bears South approx. 0.5'.
