

## CORNER RECORD (PERPETUATION)

MONUMENT: DESCRIBE NEW MONUMENT SET, OR WORK DONE TO PRESERVE EXISTING MONUMENT

Set on the crest of a ridge 100 feet northerly of and perpendicular to abandoned road 3100-287, a 5/8" by 36" rebar, with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, flush with the ground, stamped "NFU WILDERNESS AP-734 RLS 2308 1996".

ACCESSORIES: DESCRIBE NEW BT'S WITNESS OBJECTS ETC. ESTABLISHED, OR WORK DONE TO PRESERVE EXISTING EVIDENCE

15" Englemann Spruce, N. 53° E., 30.9 feet, scribed "WB/734" "BT". 21" Western Larch, N. 58 1/2° W., 23.6 feet, scribed "WB/734" "BT".

Shamrock Spring, N. 73 3/4° W., 160.7 feet.

BT's are double blazed and have a 3/4" brass washer stamped "RLS 2308" nailed to the lower blaze by the "BT" scribing.
