
History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John W. Kimbrell under GLO contract number 700, dated February 9, 1899. Surveyor General record states:

The closing corner is a basalt stone 20x12x7 ins 12 ins in the ground for closing cor of T3N R38E marked CC T3N R38E on E side with 6 grooves on N and E faces, from which;

A fir 28 ins diam bears N31°E, 175 lks dist marked CC T3N R38E S31 BT  $\,$ 



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a stone 19x11x7 inches with chisel marks visible.

Found a 36 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine stump N31°E, 175 lks with scribes visible.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: In place of the found original corner stone, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which:

New Bearing Trees and Bearing Object;
A 12 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N3°E, 185.3 feet marked T3N R38E S31 CC BT
A 16 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S67°E, 218.0 feet marked T2N R38E S6 CC BT
A 5/8"x30" iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER bears West, 4.13 feet
A 25 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N75°E, 125.9 feet marked X BT
Raised a mound of stone around monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap.
Buried the original corner stone East and alongside of monument.
Painted a 6 inch red band around all bearing trees and attached
Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I horeby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 13, 1991.
