A 3/4" x 24" aluminum rod set 22" into the ground with a 5/8" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", attached at ground level, bears N68° 30'E, 21.7 feet.

A 3/4" x 24" aluminum rod set 22" into the ground with an unmarked blue plastic cap attached to the top of the rod, and a 5/8" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", attached at ground level, bears \$46°E, 50.5 feet.

A 5/8" x 36" iron rod set 28" into the ground with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap attached, marked "LS 1636 42.0" and an arrow pointing toward the corner, bears S1° 30'W, 42.0 feet. I build a small mound of stones around this iron rod.
